

How to set a prompt for MH episodicity in SystemOne

To maintain your QOF SMI Register, a patient's diagnosis should be reviewed to determine if the patient is still symptomatic or in **remission** (criteria as below).

SMI Remission Criteria


- No record of anti-psychotic or mood stabiliser medication for at least five years.
- No mental health inpatient episodes for at least five years.
- No secondary or community care mental health follow-up for at least five years.

To record a remission code in SystemOne, the patient's earliest diagnosis must be recorded as a **New Episode**¹.

SystemOne will not prompt for you to record an episode unless this setting has been enabled. This explains why some remission codes won't remove a patient from your QOF SMI Register.

To ensure correct remission recording in the future, you will need to enable **Automatic Episodicity** in SystemOne as follows:


1. Open **Organisation Preferences** in SystemOne and select '**Prompt for episodicity if a Read code already exists with an episodicity**' as shown below.

2. Using the **Add Cluster** option, search "MH" to add the cluster for '**Psychosis, schizophrenia + bipolar affective disease codes**'.
