

Learning Disability Annual Health Assessments Clinical Systems (Ardens) Guide **SystemOne**

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1. Learning Disability Case Finder searches

- The searches shown in *Figure 1* should be used to identify patients with a code that indicates, or may indicate, a Learning Disability but who are not on LD register. The patients identified by these searches should receive a clinical review to confirm if they have a Learning Disability. This review can be face to face or a desktop review of the patient record
- If a Learning Disability is confirmed, the following code should be added: [On learning disability register \(416075005\)](#)
- This code should be inputted using the date of the initial diagnosis
- Do not add this code based on the results of the Case Finder searches alone

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2. LD register

- The search shown in *Figure 2* is used to identify patients with a confirmed Learning Disability diagnosis

- The search shown in *Figure 3* is used to identify patients who have not received an annual health assessment in the previous 13 months

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5. IIF

- The search shown in *Figure 5* is used to identify patients on the LD register who are missing one of the three elements required by IIF indicator HI-03 (annual health check + action plan + ethnicity recorded)

- The searches shown in *Figure 6* can be used to identify patients on the LD register who have elements of the IIF requirements missing

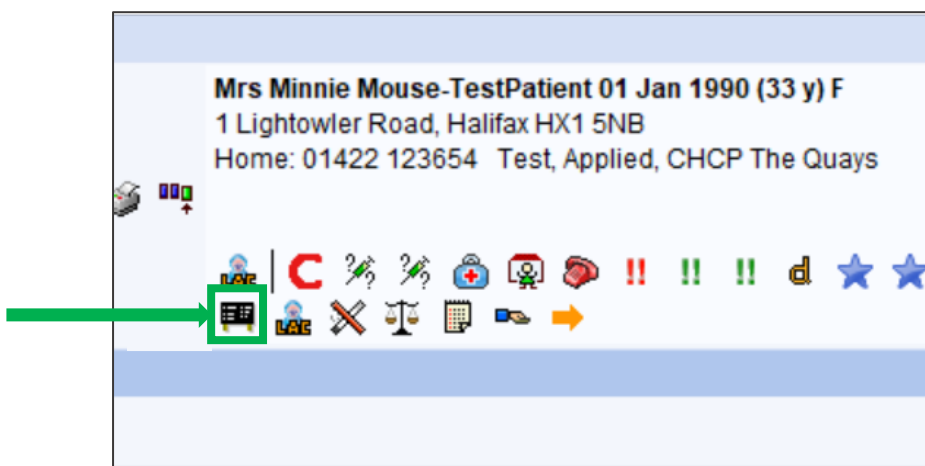

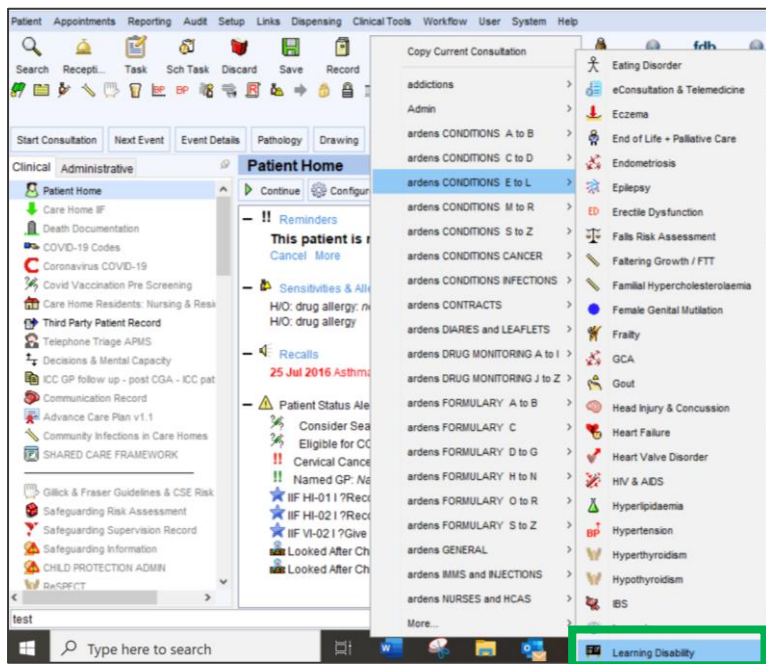

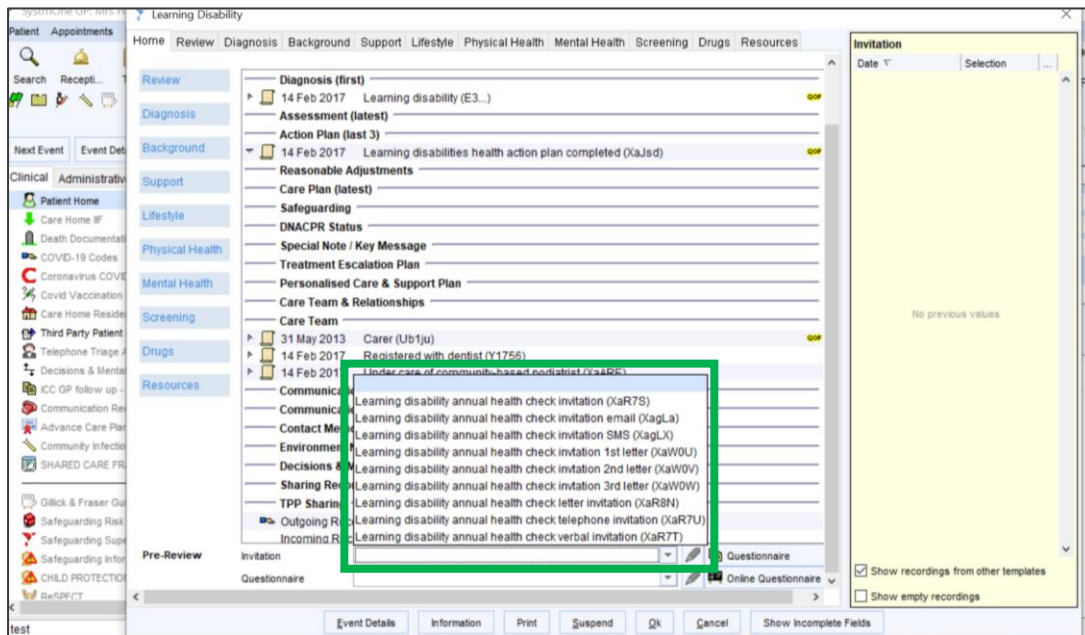
- Once the Learning Disability template has opened, you will see the screen shown in *Figure 10*

9. Invitation codes

- When inviting a patient for an Annual Health Check, the invitation codes are at the bottom of the Home tab of the Learning Disability template (you may need to scroll down to see them), as shown in *Figure 11*
- Note: alternatively, the invitation codes can be coded individually, rather than using the template. If coding individually, ensure that the correct Learning Disability invitation READ codes are used

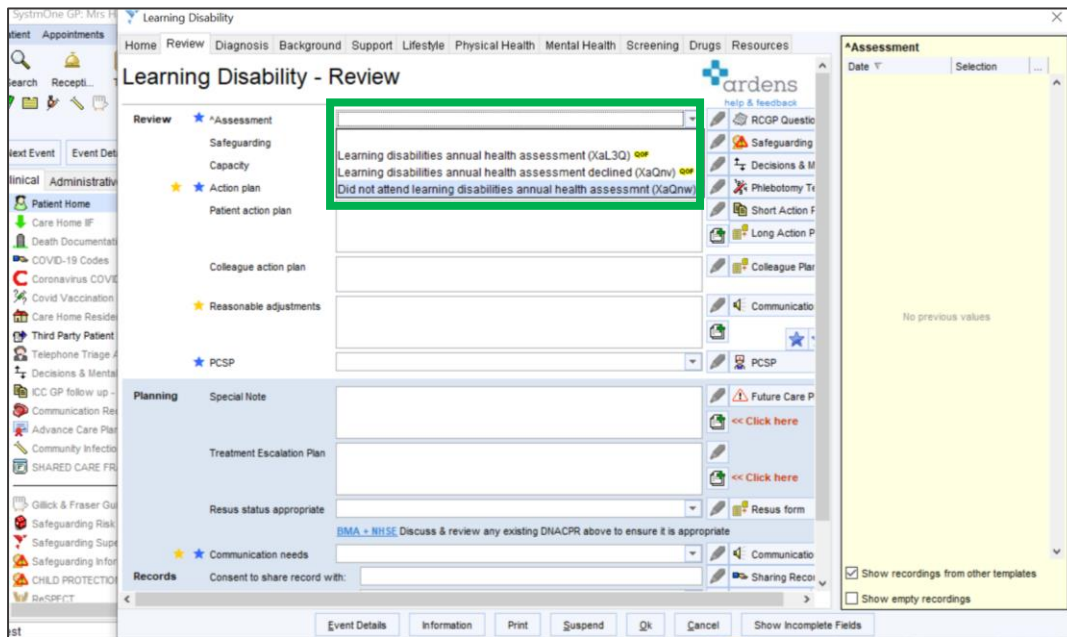


10. Assessment code

One of the 3 codes shown below in *Figure 12* should be used:

- Annual Health Assessment done – use 'Learning disabilities annual health assessment (XaL3Q)'
- Annual Health Assessment declined after invite – use 'Learning disabilities annual health assessment declined (XaQnv)'. *Note: if declined, use free text field to give reason for decline and/or reasonable adjustments offered*
- Patient accepted invite but did not attend appointment – use 'Did not attend learning disabilities annual health assessment (XaQnw)'

11. Health action plan code

- Once an annual health assessment has been completed, a health action plan should be produced and shared with the patient, and one of the 3 codes shown in Figure 13 should be used:
