

CHAMPs Awards criteria - Do not need to be register to the CISS service but must live in Hull or are registered with a Hull GP/be available to attend the awards in person.

Entry is free for all category submission.

Terms and Conditions for the Nominators.

- CHAMPs Awards are organised by CISS on behalf of the Hull Carers Partnership Board. By **Nominating** to the awards, the nominator will be deemed to have read and understood the terms and conditions of 'Award Entry' and 'Registration and Attendance' of the event and to be bound by both terms and conditions.
- **By nominating** to the CHAMPs Awards, the nominator will be deemed to have agreed to allow the details of their entry to be shared with the judges and representatives of CISS. All will be deemed to have consented to the transfer and sharing of their personal data and information for the **purpose** of administration and judging of the awards and any other purposes to which the Nominator has consented.
- The judges and CISS reserve the right at its absolute discretion to reject any entry without explanation or notice.
- All category entries must be received by submission deadline submitted by Midnight 30th September 2024 you will receive an email to confirm your submission. Entries received after the deadline will not be accepted. Neither CISS nor the judges will accept responsibility or liability for any lost, late, mislaid, or incomplete entries with all such entries deemed invalid.
- All category entries must be submitted electronically (if applicable) using the 'Entry Form'. Any entry received by any other means including via email, fax, post or hand delivered will not be accepted.
- Entrants may enter multiple award categories; all entries must be tailored for each individual category. Should entries of a winning standard not been submitted into an individual category, the judges at their absolute discretion may decline to award a winner or finalists.
- The judges and CISS reserve the right to amend category selections where it is deemed appropriate, to disqualify any entry not fitting the criteria or any entry deemed to be inaccurate, false, or misleading. In the case that an entry is disqualified.
- Category finalists and nominators will be notified via-email approximately **3** weeks prior to the awards on **25th** November 2024.
- The CHAMPs Awards are judged by a panel of independent judges without the interference or influence of CISS. The judges will shortlist up to 3 finalists from each of the 9-award category and the finalists will be announced on the – **28th October 2024**. Winners will be announced during the awards event taking place on **25th November 2024**. No details of winners will be disclosed prior to the event. One Award

winner and 2 runners-up will be announced in each category with category winners receiving trophies at the event and runners-up receiving certificate at the event. All will receive a certificate within 30 days of the event.

Terms and Conditions nominated (once notified).

- CHAMPs Awards are organised by CISS. By **accepting** the invitation to the awards, you will be deemed to have read and understood the terms and conditions of 'Attendance' of the event and to be bound by both terms and conditions, this will be deemed to have agreed to allow the details of their entry to be shared with representatives of CISS. All will be deemed to have consented to the transfer and sharing of their nominated data and information for the **purpose** of administration, promotion of the awards and CISS service.
- Nominated may bring one Guest to the awards but must be RSVP for attendance by **8th November 12noon 2024.**
- The judges' decision will be final, and no explanation, correspondence or discussion will be offered of winners before or following the judges' decision. Additionally, feedback will not be given on any successful or unsuccessful entry before or following the judges' decision.
- The judges and CIs accept no responsibility for any costs associated attending the awards.
- CISS reserves the right at its own discretion to alter or reschedule the awards, the awards luncheon and / or to change the judging panel and / or these terms at any time and without notice.
- During the award luncheon, alcoholic beverages will not be served.
- All award entrants, winners, runners-up and finalists grant CISS the exclusive right to use their name, and nomination information, for marketing of the awards, and for the commercial promotion of CISS service.
- Photography and filming by CISS approved photographers and film crews will take place during the awards event. As photographs and film footage may include images of award winners, runners-up, finalists and attendees, all award winners, runners-up, finalists, and attendees acknowledge and accept that CISS may record, photograph, film and broadcast (via print, electronic means and internet) any image or film footage taken during the awards. All winners, runners-up, finalists and attendees agree to offer CISS the exclusive right to use any image or film footage taken during the awards evening and dinner for the promotion of the awards.
- Due to data protection regulations, attendee lists for the awards luncheon are not offered by CISS.

- The attendee numbers anticipated for the awards luncheon are for guidance purposes only and CISS gives no assurance or warranty that the anticipated attendee numbers will be achieved.
- These terms shall be governed by the laws of England and Wales and the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
